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Guiding Principles

- Qualifications system is an interface between society and the system for lifelong learning
- Occupational qualifications system is an interface between labour market and the system for lifelong learning (subsystem of qualifications system)
- Qualifications system in Estonia follows integrated qualifications system model
- Qualifications system is a **quality assurance system**

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Quality assurance of curricula and formal education qualifications

- Estonian Higher Education Quality Agency (EKKA):
 - Quality assessment of study programme groups in HE
 - Institutional accreditation of HEIs
 - Quality assessment of study programme groups in VET
- Foundation *Innove*:
 - General Education Agency (national curricula for general education, national examinations)
 - VET Agency (national curricula for upper secondary VET)



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Estonian Qualifications Authority (1)

- Kutsekoda is a support structure for the national occupational qualifications system
- Occupational qualification means a qualification associated with a trade, occupation or profession resulting from work based learning
- Established in 2001 based on Occupational Qualifications Act
- Foundation in private law (tripartite)



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Estonian Qualifications Authority (2)

- *Kutsekoda* is:
 - organising and coordinating the activities of sector skills councils
 - providing counselling and assistance for awarding bodies
 - keeping the register of occupational qualifications
- NCP for the EQF implementation
- NRP for vocational qualifications
- Europass centre



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Estonian qualifications

- Formal education qualifications:
 - 4 types of qualifications in general education (3 in primary education)
 - Initial and continuous VET qualifications on levels 2-5 of the EQF
 - 4 types of qualifications in higher education (2 on bachelor's level)
- Occupational (sectoral, work based) qualifications on levels 2-8 of the EQF





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Qualification Standards

- General trend of development towards learning outcomes based standards:
 - Higher education standard (2008)
 - Vocational education standard (2008, 2013) + national curricula for VET (over 50)
 - National curriculum for basic school (2010)
 - Simplified national curriculum for basic school (2010)
 - National curriculum for upper secondary school (2010)
 - New generation of occupational standards (2010-...)

- EstQF level 5: Master carpenter, construction site manager, ...
- EstQF level 6: Engineer, ...
- EstQF level 7: Diploma engineer, diploma architect, ...
- EstQF level 8: Chartered engineer, chartered architect, ...
