Latvian Qualifications Framework (approved in October 2010 by Cabinet Regulations)

Latvian education	LQF and EQF level
Doctoral studies	8
Master's studies (HE studies at least 5 years)	7
Bachelor's studies (HE studies at least 4 years)	6
College education (2-3 years)	5
General and vocational secondary education Vocational education (arodizglītība)	4
General and vocational basic education	3
General basic education for students special needs	2
General basic education for students severe special needs	1

LQF levels	Latvian professional qualification levels
8 doctor	professional qualification level 5
7 master	the highest qualification of a specialist in a field that enables the holder to plan and perform research and scientific work in the field
6 bachelor	
5 college	professional qualification level 4 theoretical and practical background that enables the holder to perform complicated tasks as well as to organise and manage others in their work
secondary school	professional qualification level 3 advanced theoretical and professional background which enables the holder to fulfil certain tasks, including planning and organising work (various technicians, car mechanics, hotel service specialist etc.)
	professional qualification level 2 theoretical and practical background that allows the holder to perform qualified work independently (carpenter, hairdresser, cook, welder etc.)
basic school (9 grades)	professional qualification level 1 theoretical and practical training that prepares students for performing
2 spec. educ.	simple tasks in a certain area of practical activity (assistant cook, carpenter etc.)
1 spec. educ.	





- First phase (2009-2011) the establishment of the LQF; referencing formal education system to the EQF and higher education to the QF-EHEA
- Second phase (2015-2017) further development of the LQF; the revision of Self-Assessment Report on basis of new policy developments and implementation activities

 - Continuing vocational education qualifications
 - Professional development qualifications
 - Sectorial qualifications
 - International qualifications ??

- Reference in education documents to the relevant LQF/EQF level (particularly general education)
