Project "An Integrated Method to Support Migrants" takes inspiration from the recommendation "A new skills agenda for Europe" which urges to up-skill and re-skill the European labour force with digital skills, in order to keep it productive in the jobs and support adults to acquire a minimum level of key competences and acquire a broader set of skills necessary to progress towards an upper secondary qualification or equivalent. During the project lifetime, 200 low skilled unemployed adult migrants and or refugees will benefit of the pathway as testers and they will contribute, through their experience, to the validation of the final tools within an European dimension.
