## Meeting objectives

The 16th ReferNet annual meeting will be attended by national representatives for ReferNet (21 and 22 November), ReferNet members (22 and 23 November), representatives from the European Commission and the European Training Foundation, and Cedefop experts involved in ReferNet activities. It will aim at:
